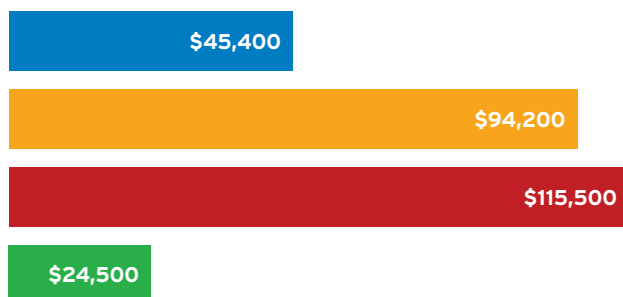
Since 2015, we have worked with local non-profits, business organizations and our Community Advisory Committee to identify projects, services, and initiatives benefitting the residents of Jefferson County communities, resulting in an investment of more than \$1 million.

SEASON OF GIVING HIGHLIGHT

As part of our Safe Communities initiative, we partnered with Port Arthur News to launch the Season of Giving campaign. Organizations serving the Port Arthur and Sabine Pass communities with programs and services that help bolster the safety of children and families were able to apply. We awarded \$25,000 in grants to 13 organizations supporting food and toy distribution events, mental health services, safety education outreach, and more.



INVESTING IN THE FUTURE

Our "Road for the Future" project represents a more than \$140 million investment in the community. As part of our Port Arthur LNG project and to improve safety, a 3.5-mile portion of Highway 87 between the Intracoastal Waterway and Keith Lake Pass was relocated and built to TxDOT standards. The effort included consolidating and upgrading pipelines running alongside the route and upgrading a City of Port Arthur's waterline segment. The new portion of the highway opened for public use in October 2021.



ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

In addition to meeting or exceeding all local, state, and federal environmental regulatory requirements on our projects, we are also proud to partner to preserve and protect wildlife habitats, restore coastal beach and wetland areas, and support beautification efforts in our communities. We work with organizations to improve our environment's sustainability in urban and natural ecosystems.

Park Restoration in Sabine Pass

In partnership with the Dick Dowling Lion's Club and Texas Parks & Wildlife, more than 50 employees and their families participated in a clean-up and beautification of Bert Karrer Lion's Park in Sabine Pass during Earth Month. Our team collected more than 40 bags of garbage and debris, removed rusted playground equipment and picnic tables, built new park benches, and replanted flower beds.



ECONOMIC PROSPERITY AND LEADERSHIP

At Port Arthur LNG, we are proud to contribute to the region's economic prosperity with investments in job creation, new infrastructure, and support of community programs that help build resiliency. We focus on partnerships that provide for our communities' responsible growth and development and foster engagement with local leadership on key regional issues to inspire open communication, trust, and respect.

Conversations Facilitating Best Practices

We teamed up with the Port Arthur Chamber of Commerce to underwrite a new "Best Practice" roundtable series focused on industry education & outreach with a variety of stakeholder groups. In 2021, the Chamber hosted its first dialogue with industry and media. More than 50 attendees shared ideas on enhancing the relationship with local media and improving the accessibility to industry information vital for the public.



EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS & SAFETY

Our workforce and communities' health, safety, and security are at the center of everything we do. Through our emergency preparedness and safety initiatives, we build on partnerships with the Port Arthur Police and Fire Departments and the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department to support programs that keep our communities safe. Additionally, we fund local nonprofit organizations that help eradicate hunger, provide health care screenings and services, and assist families needing help paying their bills.

SAFE Communities Health & Wellness Fairs

With COVID-19 still impacting our communities, we partnered with health & wellness organizations to provide free health screenings, wellness & mental health checks and free COVID vaccinations and flu shots. In partnership with Port Arthur ISD and the City of Port Arthur's Health Services Department, we supported a health and wellness forum for students and their families.



EDUCATION | STEM

We champion people by investing in their development, empowering innovation and creativity, and celebrating accomplishments. We are proud to partner with local schools, colleges and universities including Sabine Pass ISD, Port Arthur ISD, Lamar State College-Port Arthur and Lamar University. By supporting innovative programs in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM), we help grow our future leaders and workforce.

Inspiring Future Leaders

In 2021, we increased funding of scholarship programs that provide greater access to education for students of diverse backgrounds.

We expanded our partnerships with NAACP - Beaumont Chapter, 100 Plus Black Women Coalition and the Port Arthur Education Foundation to

benefit exceptional high school students throughout Jefferson County dedicated to furthering their education. More than 15 scholarships were awarded to our next generation of thinkers, doers, and game-changers through these efforts.
