OUR COMMITMENT

At Port Arthur LNG, our goal is to build a world-class facility to provide abundant, clean, reliable and affordable U.S. natural gas to the world. Equally important are the relationships and positive impact we make in the community along the way. By living our values of doing the right thing, championing people, and shaping the future, we build strong community partnerships that are paramount to developing trust and transparency. We work with local community groups

to invest in projects and initiatives in the areas of emergency preparedness and safety, environmental stewardship, education, economic prosperity and leadership development.

Since 2015, when Port Arthur LNG's liquefaction project development started, we have invested more than \$1.8 million in Jefferson County communities with organizations helping to make our neighborhoods a better place to work, live and play.

PORT ARTHUR LNG COMMUNITY INITIATIVES

Port Arthur LNG partnered with the Port Arthur News to champion the efforts of local non-profit organizations providing critical programs and services to our neighbors and local communities. Through this partnership, we implemented community initiatives in these three impact areas:



Environmental Champions

This initiative awarded \$50,000 in grants to thirteen local non-profit organizations with programs aimed at improving the environment in the communities of Port Arthur and Sabine Pass. Efforts included community restoration and beautification projects.



Safe Communities

Port Arthur LNG provided \$40,000 to fund local non-profit organizations that help eradicate hunger, provide health care screenings and mental health services, and assist communities in staying healthy and safe.



Season of Giving

In its second year, Port Arthur LNG awarded \$56,000 in grants to eighteen organizations helping individuals and families have a happier and healthier holiday. These efforts included providing hot meals and food delivery, holiday toys and warm clothing, and bill assistance to families in need.



ROAD FOR THE FUTURE

The relocation of a 3.5-mile portion of Highway 87 between the Intracoastal Waterway and Keith Lake Pass was completed in 2022, meeting the rigorous Texas Department of Transportation standards. As part of the relocation construction project, pipelines were consolidated and upgraded including a portion of the City of Port Arthur's waterline serving the Sabine Pass community. Port Arthur LNG invested more than \$40 million with 35 local vendors in Jefferson County communities to procure needed materials and services. Additionally, the National Safety Council awarded Port Arthur LNG a Perfect Record Award in recognition of the more than 1.7 million hours worked without a recordable safety incident.









2022 COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP HIGHLIGHTS

ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

One of our priorities at Port Arthur LNG is to work with organizations to improve our environment's sustainability in urban and natural ecosystems. We seek out and invest in efforts that help preserve and protect wildlife habitats, restore the coastal beach and wetland areas and support beautification efforts in our communities.

Sea Rim State Park Kids' Fish

As one of our most popular employee engagement activities, Sea Rim State Park's Kids Fish event, hosted by Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, engaged more than 50 of our Environmental Champions who volunteered their time to assist kids with baiting hooks, measuring fish and returning them safely back to the surf.

Canceled the past two years due to COVID, this popular event returned in July 2022 with more than 700 community members in attendance. Over 275 children participated in the fishing tournament, learning important environmental and safety lessons while enjoying a beautiful day at the beach.



EDUCATION | STEM

At Port Arthur LNG, we champion people by investing in their growth and development, empowering innovation and creativity, and celebrating accomplishments. We are proud to partner with local schools in the Sabine Pass and Port Arthur Independent School Districts, and colleges and universities like Lamar State College and Lamar University. By supporting science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) programs, we help grow our future leaders and workforce.



Bob Hope School

In 2022, Port Arthur LNG partnered with the Bob Hope School to fund a new environmental sustainability education curriculum supporting the school's growing agriculture program. The curriculum allows students hands-on experience raising chickens and building raised garden beds where they learn gardening basics and harvest their vegetables. The school aims to grow this program into the first Port Arthur area Future Farmers of America chapter, with plans to add small greenhouse kits, animal evaluation books used for vocational agriculture competitions, and other supplies to teach agriculture science and sustainability.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS & SAFETY

Safety is a core value at Port Arthur LNG. We are invested in being an industry leader and accomplish this by championing health, safety and security programs that protect our people, contractors and operations. Through our emergency preparedness and safety initiatives, we build on partnerships with local law enforcement, as well as fire and rescue departments to support programs that protect our communities. We also fund local non-profit organizations that help eradicate hunger, provide vital health screenings and services, and assist families needing help paying their bills.

Crime Stoppers of Southeast Texas

A long-time supporter of Southeast Texas Crime Stoppers, our 2022 partnership included the sponsorship of the statewide Crime Stoppers School Campus program. This effort brought students from throughout the state of Texas together in Beaumont to discuss and collaborate on ways to prevent dangerous and potentially life-threatening situations from occurring among student populations both on and off campus. Crime Stoppers of Southeast Texas serves Jefferson, Orange and Hardin counties and sponsors 18 school campus programs in the Golden Triangle area.
